The class is cleverly structured not to get your toddler ‘wired’ and quiet activities have a clearly defined place where you and your toddler enjoy a more cosy time together.

Support from the educator to help make you a confident and happy ‘music teacher’ for your child and like minded mums and carers to swap stories and chat to make my class a safe, affirming and social place to be.
